In starting a Boys Camp, the big question on everybody's mind it seems is, "When do you hope to have boys there?" Good question. Enrollment is the main thing we're working toward, and while we can project some dates, it's a bit early to have a solid answer.

A question we can answer with more certainty is "What needs to be in place before we're ready for boys?

Three things come to mind: buildings, legal authorization, and staff. Laying the groundwork for legal authorization and forming a staff team, are gradual processes that need defined and are in development.

Buildings are a more objective need and offer a clear opportunity for people who are interested in helping. There are four building projects planned before we are ready to enroll boys.

- 1. A large maintenance building (currently under construction) that will also be the location of a temporary kitchen and dining hall.
- 2. A building to serve as a temporary office. (Plans are to use it as living quarters when a more permanent office is built later.)
- 3. A staff house large enough for a small family, some single staff, and some guest quarters.
- 4. A laundry/shower house.

Our next building project is the office and living quarters. We need to raise \$250,000 by Dec. 31, 2023 to be fully funded.

The \$580,000 in interest-free private loans for the purchase of the land is outstanding.
